WATER / GAS / SEWER / SEWER LAGOONS / STREETS / PARK

Item 1. Water

In Month of May 2022, we produced 12.790 MG of finished water.

Max Day was 0.493 MG.

Min Day was 0.224 MG.

Ave. Day was 0.410 MG.

Repaired three water leaks in system.

There were two new water taps made in system.

Still having communication problems at Hwy. 59 water booster station.

Item 2. Gas

Sniff test have been done for month of June.

We still need to bypass gas regulator station at Richland Hills entrance from accident.

Annual Review of all gas manuals is in process with Mr. Jerry Foreman of Tri-Star Energy.

Item 3. Sewer / Sewer Lagoons

Lift Station on Mason / Charleston Road down again: estimated cost to repair \$11,477.90.

Scorecard for water and wastewater has been submitted.

Item 4. Streets

Prices on paving Gainesville Lane and Mason Charleston Road. Estimated cost \$105,000 each street.

Waiting for comptroller approval on truck for public works department .

Item 5. Park

Looking at putting fall break material in park playground areas.
