

APRIL 2024 COMMITTEE REPORT

- 1. Mason Fire Department responded to a total of 17 incidents for March 2024 with a 100% response rate:
 - 8 EMS Calls
 - 2 EMS Calls (Tipton County)
 - 1 Motor Vehicle Accident W/ Injuries
 - 1 Service Call
 - 2 Structure Fires (Tipton County)
 - 1 Illegal Burn (Tipton County)
 - 2 Automatic Fire Alarms (Tipton County)
- 2. Annual pump testing was completed on April 2nd by Safe Industries. All apparatus passed testing and received needed pump maintenance.
- 3. Grants funds were received in the amount of \$588.00 from the Safety Partners Grant from Public Entity Partners to reimburse for the purchase of structural firefighting gloves.
- 4. The department has sold its 1998 Pierce Saber on Gov Deals for the amount of \$2,505.00. Payment will be received once the vehicle has shipped.
- 5. The anticipated 2024 MTAS revised work plan for the fire department has been received and provided to the Mayor & Board of Aldermen. Key points include the need for:
 - Increased department staffing through both paid and volunteer personnel.
 - Replacement of current fire station facilities.
 - Introduction of a sprinkler ordinance.
- 6. It is being requested that the Town purchase one to two multi-gas meters for both the fire department and Alliance. Current equipment is unreliable and outdated. The department currently does not have any gas detection equipment for service calls when dispatched for natural gas incidents.
- 7. The department is requesting that the repairs to the fire station wall be put out for 30 days sealed bid.

8.	The annual fire hydrant service and testing is projected to be completed by Rogers Hydrant Service in May of 2024. This years' service will include all fire hydrants on Mason's water distribution system in the county areas.
