



JANUARY 2024 COMMITTEE REPORT

1. Mason Fire Department responded to a total of 159 total incidents for the year of 2023.
2. Mason Fire Department responded to a total of 30 incidents of December 2023:
 - 17 EMS CALLS
 - 1 EMS CALL (TIPTON COUNTY)
 - 1 MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT W/ NO INJURIES
 - 1 MOTER VEHICLE ACCIDENT W/ INJURIES (TIPTON COUNTY)
 - 1 VEHICLE FIRE
 - 2 GRASS FIRES (TIPTON COUNTY)
 - 4 STRUCTURE FIRES (TIPTON COUNTY)
 - 2 AUTOMATIC FIRE ALARMS (TIPTON COUNTY)
 - 1 DOWNED POWER LINES
3. The department was selected as a recipient of the Tennessee Volunteer Fire Assistance Grant through The Tennessee Department of Agriculture, Division of Forestry. This grant is valued at \$,3000.00 in wildland firefighting equipment. The department received a total of two backpack blowers, five wildland helmets, and five goggles. This grant will greatly assist the department as it responds to numerous wildland fire incidents annually.
4. Annual apparatus maintenance and pump testing is anticipated to be completed by the end of January.
5. The department has completed it's 2023 annual in-service training program. This program provides both full-time and volunteer fire personnel with an annual stipend provided by the Tennessee Commission on Firefighting. Volunteer personnel who complete the required training hours receive \$600.00 annually while full-time receive \$800.00. This year' the department had seven volunteers and two full-time complete the program grossing \$5,800.00.
